A Note From Fr. Jim Kinney

This weekend we celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi. Although Easter is now seen in our rear view mirror, the glory of the Resurrection spills over into Ordinary time and this solemnity where it is central to its reality. Teilhard DeChardin, a Jesuit priest and renowned paleontologist, has captured this stunning reality in his "Mass on the World", a work cited in various ways by Popes Benedict and John Paul II but largely unknown by most Catholics and Christians.

In the words of Pope Benedict, "Teilhard went on to give a new meaning to Christian worship. The transubstantiated Host is the anticipation of the transformation and divinization of matter in the Christological "fullness". In his view, the Eucharist provides the movement of the cosmos with its direction; it anticipates its goal and at the same time urges it on."

I strongly recommend that every parishioner read DeChardin's "Mass". In lieu of further explication of DeChardin's work, I offer a mere couple of the takeaways from the book. When we see the Host raised during the Offertory, offer all the good things we have been graced to do during the week. When we see the chalice raised, offer all the sins and failures we have succumbed to as well, understanding that they have been washed away by Christ's blood. And get to know more about this Jesuit visionary who has not only posited the science of evolution but given even greater depth to our understanding of Christ's impact on our universe and the future Church.
