A Note From Fr. Jim Kinney

"Difficult and dangerous times. Intolerant religious leaders disdain the "deviants." Prophetic voices are silenced as a threat to others. Hungry people holding what little they have. This describes the environment of today's Gospel -- and ours?" Thus Sister Mary McGlone begins her exegesis of today's scripture. How often do we question whether the scripture's are meant for us, for our own time, for our own struggles with our faith? Are we, like the other disciples, sitting safely in our proverbial boat while that crazy apostle, Peter, makes a fool of himself with the flaws of his faith causing him to sink in the turbulent waters?

What sort of well-fed faith do we have that compels us to avoid that first step Peter took after asking for the Lord's invitation? Do we take refuge in a retreat pursued not so much by a gut wrenching leap of faith but the quiet whispering sound of our conscience?

Let us remember that Peter took that first step just as he had many times before- following the Lord, then failing, then following the Lord again. And just as the Lord plucked him from the roiling waters of the sea, we can trust the Lord to do the same as we depart from our fears and dare to be the "deviant" who challenges the accepted mediocrities of a comfortable but tepid life of faith.
