#### A Note From Fr. Jim Kinney

This Sunday's gospel contains some rather harsh words from Jesus for the pagan Canaanite woman. However we choose to rationalize those words comparing the woman to a "dog", it shows how easily we can dismiss Jesus' humanity and the imperfections that characterize his humanity as he silently struggles with his identity, mission and prejudices. We also can see how quickly he responds to faith when it confronts him so directly as when this woman shows the same persistence as the woman who pleads her case before the unjust judge- a proverb that Jesus himself shares elsewhere. Compare that to his relative powerlessness when his own Jewish neighbors see and hear him as merely the "carpenter's son."

Jesus, just as we humans must, had to learn the signs of the times in the scriptures, in prayer, in events and in people such as this woman who has two strikes against her being pagan as well as a woman. But due to her faith, there is no third strike against this Gentile, only Jesus' healing accolade, "great is your faith."

Not only Matthew's first-century Jewish community needs to examine its prejudices. It would do all of us well to see our own racism, sexism and cultural superiority that we see reflected in this gospel. As long as there are "dogs (under) the table"---people in misery, people on the margins of or excluded from the church---we are challenged to cross boundaries and offer them the crumbs of our compassion.
