A Note From Fr. Jim Kinney

Our scripture this Sunday is all about nursing our anger as sinners but, by God's good graces, finding a just peace through forgiveness and reconciliation- a lifelong process. In this Season of Creation (Sept.1- Oct.4) we might take Sirach's parable from the vantage point of being creatures given an undeserved bounty of life and possibility. Life, a pure gift of God, has been given to us and to every part of creation.

Sirach talked about those cherishing wrath. Sr. Mary McGlone suggests: how about the alternative of cherishing gratitude? We might marvel about our bodies' remarkable powers of regeneration and healing. We might also look to all the climate activists prophetically calling us to care for and heal the earth as we care for the poor and the millions of migrants searching for arable lands despite the flood waters as well as the droughts and the fire storms that have driven them away from homes and lands, now in ruin.

As parishioners of St. Joseph we should also be willing to support those in our Diocese through our commitments to the ongoing DAA campaign which goes beyond the needs of our parish to those 40 some parishes whose collections can not fully fund their salaries or their operations without assistance from the DAA and your generous contributions. There are also some 14 parishes providing a home for pastors who would not have a pastoral home without being subsidized by the DAA - please think of Fr. Frank Brawner in Our Lady of the Mountains in Stanton.
