A Note From Fr. Jim Kinney

This Sunday's solemnity includes the title of "King", not a title that readily comes to mind when we think of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Certainly less so than Ezekiel's choice of "Shepherd." When Pope Pius IX created this solemnity, he wanted to reestablish Christ's sovereignty over all of Creation and humanity despite the darker side of secularism which might beg to differ. In the current age where scientists continue to discover and unveil the mysteries of the universe- not the least of which are the incredibly gorgeous visions taken by the Hubble Space Telescope- any earthly title of Christ is bound to fall short of Christ, the co-Creator and the very center of all the human mind stands in righteous awe of.

But as we head into Advent and toward the celebration of Christ's humble beginnings, today's gospel captures the essence, and the paradox, of Our Lord and Redeemer, best envisioned as present to the hungry, the stranger, the unclothed, the sick and the imprisoned- those for whom he implores our service and readily identifies as his brothers and sisters.
