A Note From Fr. Jim Kinney

Prophets. You either hate them or you love them. One of the more delightful cartoons that Sr. Mary McGlone says she has seen lately shows a puzzled man standing in a secondhand store looking at a display of antique "The end is near" signs. We all have more or less been taught, or otherwise believe, that the world will end. And, for some people, sooner rather than later. Paul and his communities expected Christ to return in glory before most of them died. And while Paul exaggerates the imminence of Christ's second coming and the virtue of those who remain single, Vatican II points out that all of God's people are called to holiness, not just the hierarchy or celibate.

Some theologians now accept the theological insights of Jesuit mystic and renowned paleontologist Teilhard DeChardin along with St Paul, St. Bonaventure, Dun Scotus, St. Francis, Zachery Hayes and others who see God present in all of creation via the primacy of Christ. Accordingly, they believe creation will persist until God is all in all and perfectly united in Christ, the alpha and omega of all creation. The earlier Christian communities had to reorient their expectations and their spirituality. They began to understand that Christ remained present to them and that they had a much larger and longer mission than they initially discerned.

Similarly, per our first reading, Moses promises the people that God will not abandon them, but rather continue to speak to them through prophets. And prophets did not end with Christ but arise to this very day and onward. Prophets like Oscar Romero, Martin Luther King and all those who speak truth to power. Similarly to their astonishment as Christ's authoritative word removed the unclean spirit from a man, modern prophets are met with amazement, joy and often anger when prophecies alight at the feet of those guarding their power, wealth and privilege
