A Note From Fr. Jim Kinney

Augustinian priest Fr Bob Dueweke teaches at Berea College and has made countless presentations at other prestigious national academic institutions and even represented the Augustinian mission at the UN. Last week he made presentations on the Second Vatican Council at St Agatha and St Patrick in Mt Sterling. In the audience were all the teachers and staff of SAA as well as St Joseph's Council members and catechists for both parishes.

Vatican II is part of the official Church magisterium, or teachings of the Church. Planning began in 1959 and took place from 1962 to 1965. The theological and liturgical changes recommended by the Council were in their incipient stages years and even several decades before they were implemented in 1965. Many if not the vast majority of American Catholics are unaware of these teachings and even the major themes of the Council. Unless you are over 70 years of age you were probably not all that aware they were going on. But what you would have noticed were the liturgical changes, particularly in the presentation and language of the mass going from Latin to English.

Fr Bob's presentations were largely well received by his audiences here and we believe many if not most parishioners at St. Joseph and St. Patrick would want to know about these teachings. They are to a significant degree behind the reforms that Pope Francis is implementing in his papacy which have received enthusiastic support from our Bishop and other bishops in spite of opposition from members of the hierarchy still uncomfortable with the changes that the Council advocated. If a significant number of you are interested, Fr Bob will gladly offer them the same presentation.

Please let Fr Jim know if you are interested and we will schedule one. Blessings, Fr. Jim
