A Note From Fr. Jim Kinney

Those preparing for their baptism this Easter will celebrate the second of three "scrutinies." They will be learning to "scrutinize" or to distinguish "the treasure from the trash" of their lives- not unlike those suffering from addictions will do as they go through the so-called "Twelve Step" process.

Whether we are addicted to points serious or less so, as we rehearse once again the promises of the baptism we have already made, or will undertake for the first time, or merely the promises made at the beginning of Lent, all of us can see the discernments made in the selection of David in our first reading or the discernment of the newly-sighted man healed by Christ as rich food for our own ongoing conversion.

In the scripture this weekend, we should note the failures of the would-be discerners of God's work in their lives as the possible pitfalls in our own process of discerning God's will in our own lives. We should ask if the potentially false pride we have in our various authorities- as parents, employers, students, judges, doctors, pastors or wherever authority may reside- have prevented us from seeing God's work in those over whom we exercise authority. May God be with you as you so discern his will.

Norms of the Church for Lenten Penance

FAST - Good Friday are days of fast. On days of fast, one full meal and two lesser meals are allowed. Eating between meals is not permitted. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are bound to fast.

ABSTINENCE - The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. On days of abstinence, meat may not be taken. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years of age or older. If members of the Faithful are unable to observe the fast and abstinence regulations because of ill health or other reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of penance and self-denial suitable to their condition.
