Easter Sunday He Has Risen!! Alleluia!! A Note From Fr. Jim Kinnev

This past week I was asked to speak to the divisions that haunt our Church as well as the society in which our Holy Mother the Church is embedded. But I don't choose to recapitulate all the various and sundry ways in which the "Whole-liness" of our unity in Christ is challenged. Rather, I prefer to speak to the root causes of those rather obvious divisions for anyone who has eyes to see and ears to hear- beginning with fear. That is the fear of change, fear of the evolving world, and fear of dying unto ourselves as Christ did throughout his life and, in particular, as he embraced all of creation- his arms spread wide on the crossaccepting death as the vehicle all of us will undergo and to be born anew for the gift of life everlasting.

Fear can also be paralyzing, freezing us in a longing for the past and the illusion that the past is better than anything the future may hold in store. In fact the future is where Christ's perfect love and fortitude is drawing us inevitably and irrevocably. Evolution is in the very nature of all of creation and the whole-liness all of creation continues to evolve toward the omega, the Christ, in which we all are members being brought to perfection as the uniquely gifted persons each and every one of us was created to be. We are, in a sense, grafted onto God in a way that our life is now part of God's life and God's life is part of our life; We are to "put on" Christ as St. Paul has suggested in his letter to the Romans. Let us never fear to renew ourselves in Christ and do away with the old wineskins into which new wine should not be poured.


