**HISTORY OF OUR ST. JOSEPH CHURCH...** By 1918, the Sisters of the Congregation of Divine Providence were encouraged to open a school in the Winchester area. Through their efforts the St. Agatha Academy was established. The school flourished as a boarding and day school for both boys and girls. Students of all religious beliefs were accepted in the elementary and secondary programs. From its earliest days the Academy has enjoyed an excellent reputation among the townspeople, in 1953, a new convent and classroom building were completed. It was also at this time that a parish hall was built under the direction of Monsignor John Danz.
