HISTORY OF OUR ST. JOSEPH CHURCH... In the 1960's and early 1970's some changes were made in the Academy which reflected some of the changes taking place in Catholic education throughout the country. Because of rising costs, shortage of students, it became necessary to discontinue the high school and the seventh and eighth grades. It was also during this time that the Academy ceased to take boarders.
