A Note From Fr. Jim Kinney

Poet Laureate Maya Angelou once wrote about her grandmother's great faith and, how looking into a distant sky as if willing herself into the heavens, she proclaimed, "I will step out onto the word of God." In today's readings we have a similar image of Jesus "taken up" into the sky, having spent an earthly lifetime stepping out on the word of God. In today's reading from the Acts, Jesus advised his disciples about their forthcoming baptism in the Spirit. Later, as he ascended to his Father, two angels would urge them to get about the good work Jesus had prepared them for.

And indeed, they would do so, propelled with great joy and the power of the Holy Spirit as they would pay witness to the good news "to the ends of the earth." At the outset of the Acts of the Apostles, Jesus prepares his disciples for their own journey, and particularly how they will require the Spirit's empowering gifts, not the least of which will be the joy which inevitably is found in any mission to be done well.

As Christ ascends to the Father, the mission he began is carried on through the church, the community of believers on earth. Our work of evangelization does not simply consist of passing on the Commandments or some list of teachings; we proclaim Christ crucified! This is the kerygma, the essence of our faith. When we share the story of our salvation, we share the reason for our hope- and our joy.
